Board of Medicine Concerns

 Potential for conflicting decisions – Complaint process vs. Civil process
 Separation of staff
 Breadth of professions covered
 Cumbersome and costly process



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- Fiscal note \$365,000 annually
- Conservative estimate
- Staff Executive Director, Full-Time Prelitigation Manager, Paralegal, Office Assistant, Financial Officer
- Office space for staff, review hearings
- Office equipment and furnishings



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Other Costs

 Panel chairperson - \$2,000 per case cap (\$250 per diem)

• Panel members - \$350 per case

• Travel expenses



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- SB 560 does not compel participation by practitioners or attorneys in the Review Panel process
- No funding stream identified



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Surrounding states – KY

 Kentucky: SB 4 passed in 2017 (effective 6/29) establishes MRPs under the Cabinet for Health & Family Services (DHHR equivalent); requires \$125 filing fee and \$12 mailing fee

 - Panel consists of one judge, two practitioners, two attorneys

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Surrounding states – OH, PA, MD
 – OH: voluntary arbitration

– PA: certificates of merit

 MD: Health Care Alternative Dispute Resolution Office (arbitration)



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- Idaho: Only state/jurisdiction in which panel rests with the Board of Medicine
- 100-138 hearings completed annually over the past decade
- Impact is unclear




