With a quorum of members present, Dr. Sheth called the meeting to order, and attendance was documented by Ms. Frame.

CALL TO ORDER

In order to minimize interruptions, Dr. Sheth asked all members to silence their cell phones.

Dr. Sheth announced that Mr. Spangler is unable to attend today's meeting; however, he sends his regrets and his appreciation for the time and dedication of members and staff during the meeting weekend.

Dr. Sheth introduced and welcomed the Board's Fiscal Officer, Evelyn Bush. Ms. Bush joined the Board in May, following the departure of Deborah Scott, who served the Board for many years, most recently in an interim capacity. The Board wishes Ms. Scott the best in her retirement and looks forward to working with Ms. Bush.

Dr. Sheth recognized Sheree Thompson, Supervisor of the Licensing, Certification & Renewals Division, and presented her with a Certificate of Appreciation for twenty years of loyal and dedicated service to the State of West Virginia.

Ms. Thompson left the meeting room at this time and was not present for the remainder of the meeting.

Dr. Sheth acknowledged the work of the licensure division. In addition to processing new licensure applications, licensure staff, with the assistance of Ms. Alley, Melissa Cross and Ms. Frame, successfully processed over 4,300 renewal applications during the 2023 renewal period.

Dr. Sheth acknowledged the work of the Investigation, Complaints & Compliance Division. The staff of this division have been very busy over the past several months. Their hard work and dedication is greatly appreciated.

Dr. Sheth reported that Mr. Spangler, Dr. Patel, Melissa Cross and Ms. Frame attended Administrators in Medicine conference and the 2023 Federation of State Medical Boards Annual Meeting in Minneapolis, Minnesota in May. The meetings were very

informative and offered a platform for networking with other licensing boards. The 2024 Federation of State Medical Boards Meeting will be held April 18-20, 2024 in Nashville, Tennessee. Dr. Sheth encouraged any member who is interested in attending the 2024 meeting to contact Mr. Spangler or Ms. Frame for additional information.

Prior to today's meeting, the draft May 1, 2023 meeting minutes were made available for members to review. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that the May 1, 2023 meeting minutes be approved as presented. Mr. Wooton seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

In the absence of Mr. Spangler, Ms. Alley thanked Mr. Foster, Ms. Thompson, Ms. Thornton, and Ms. Frame for their work in preparation for and during the weekend committee meetings.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Ms. Alley reiterated that board members are encouraged to attend the 2024 Federation of State Medical Board's Annual Meeting.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Executive/Management Committee met yesterday, July 9, 2023, at which time the Committee reviewed the fiscal report and purchasing card transactions for the months of April, May and June 2023. The Board continues to remain in a good financial position. As Mr. Spangler has not had an opportunity to review the fiscal reports and purchasing card transactions, the Committee deferred acceptance of the documents to the September 2023 meeting.

EXECUTIVE / MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

Dr. Sheth reported that the Board was recently audited by the West Virginia Purchasing Division. All areas of noncompliance were relatively minor in nature. Board staff are preparing a Corrective Action Plan to be submitted to the Purchasing Division. Board staff will continue to attend training sessions offered by the West Virginia Purchasing Division and will stay apprised of purchasing requirements.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Board has contracted with five hearing examiners and one court reporting agency for Fiscal Year 2024.

Dr. Sheth reported that in response to legislation that was passed during the 2023 regular session of the West Virginia Legislature, the Board is required to make a roster of licensed or registered practitioners available on the Board's website. The roster must include the practitioner's name, mailing address and the municipality or county of residence. Historically, mailing addresses have not been provided on the website. Prior to publishing a roster with the new components on the Board's website, the Committee directed Board staff to engage in outreach and provide current credential holders notice, with an opportunity to review and update his/her current mailing address. To provide adequate notice, the new roster will be published ninety days after notice and will be updated monthly thereafter. The Committee also authorized staff to include public information in the roster which is most commonly requested by public records requests, such as license numbers, statuses and expiration dates.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee directed staff to conduct a review of all Board of Medicine applications to determine if modernization is needed. The review will focus on ensuring that the application questions are evidence based and relate to eligibility standards and appropriate public protection.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee received an update regarding 2023 renewal. Renewal statistics will be provided later this morning as part of the Licensure Committee Report.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee reviewed an inquiry regarding whether an IV Infusion Center needs to register with the Board of Medicine as a medical corporation/company. The Committee directed Board staff to reply to the inquiry and advise that registration with the Board is not required at this time.

Prior to today's meeting, a proposed comment related to amendments to rules promulgated by the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission (IMLCC), was made available for members to review. Dr. Sheth reported that the IMLCC is accepting written comments with regard to proposed amendments to three IMLCC rules through 8:00 pm Eastern Time today, July 10, 2023. The Committee recommended that the Board authorize staff to submit the comment to the IMLCC with respect to the proposed amendments to IMLCC rules three, four and six, as presented. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Sheth reported that Mr. Spangler continues to work with the West Virginia Office of Technology to seek upgrades to the technology in the boardroom and the conference room.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Board is in the process of entering into a one-year extension of the current contract with the Board's database vendor, Big Picture. It is anticipated that the database and website will be placed out for bid by September 2023.

Dr. Sheth reported that Mr. Spangler will begin accepting staff applications for participation in the Telework Pilot Project later this month.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee received an update on the following litigation matters:

- JH v. West Virginia Board of Medicine this matter remains pending before the Unites States Supreme Court. The West Virginia Attorney General's Office is representing the Board in this matter.
- Mass Litigation Opioid Litigation Pharmacy Case the claim against Kroger has been settled.

Dr. Sheth reported that in June 2023, the Legislative Committee met and authorized Board staff to file Notice of Comment Period with regard to W. Va. Code R. § 11-1B-1 et seq., Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures.

Continuing Education, Physician Assistants, and W. Va. Code R. § 11-6-1 et seq., Continuing Education for Physicians and Podiatric Physicians. The comment period concludes at 4:30 pm on July 21, 2023. No substantive comments have been received to date; therefore, the Legislative Committee did not meet this weekend, but will need to meet in July following the conclusion of the comment period to consider any comments received. The Committee recommended that the Board authorize the Legislative Committee to act on behalf of the Board as necessary with regard to rulemaking, including authorizing an agency approved version of W. Va. Code R. § 11-1B-1 et seq. and W. Va. Code R. § 11-6-1 et seq. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Executive/Management Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Foster reported that a hearing convened in May 2023. This matter will likely come before the Board for action in September 2023.

BOARD ATTORNEY REPORT

Mr. Foster reported that on March 14, 2022 the Board issued a *Final Decision and Order* in the matter of *West Virginia Board of Medicine, Petitioner*, v. *Mark Samaan, MD, Respondent*, Complaint No. 18-175-M. The Respondent filed an appeal in Kanawha County Circuit Court which was dismissed. He later filed an appeal in Kanawha County Intermediate Court. Briefs have been filed, and this case is pending a decision by the court.

In the absence of Ms. Takubo, Dr. Patel chaired the Physician Assistant Committee meeting on Saturday, July 8, 2023, and provided the Physician Assistant Committee Report.

Dr. Patel reported that the Committee received a report from Board staff regarding 2023 renewal. Renewal for physicians whose last names begin with the letters M through Z, all podiatric physicians, corresponding controlled substance dispensing practitioner registrations, educational permits and professional limited liability companies began on May 3, 2023 and concluded at 4:30 pm Eastern Daylight Time on June 30, 2023. A Renewal Statistic Chart, which provides the number of licenses, permits and registrations which were eligible to renew, the number that renewed, and the number that expired due to nonrenewal was made available for members to review. The chart is attached to these minutes as Attachment 4 and is incorporated herein by reference.

Dr. Patel reported that the Committee received a report on licensure activity for fiscal year 2023, which began on July 1, 2022 and concluded on June 30, 2023. Over 2,000 initial credentials were issued during fiscal year 2023. Of note, Interstate Medical Licensure Compact pathway licensing continues to grow, and accounts for almost fifty percent of all new medical doctor licensees.

Ms. Thornton left the meeting room at this time.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Licensure Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Patel, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Complaint Committee has one additional matter to report which requires Board action. On March 23, 2021, Matthew Steven Zell, MD entered into a Consent Order with the Board and has been compliant with the terms and conditions of his probation. Dr. Zell has petitioned the Board to modify the Consent Order and lift the probationary status. The Committee recommended that the Board enter an Order terminating Dr. Zell's Consent Order. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Complaint Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Foster reported that on May 19, 2014, the Board revoked the medical license of Oscar Pagalilauan Gosien, MD, License Number 12476, pursuant to W. Va. Code § 30-3-14(d), which imposes a nondiscretionary duty upon the Board to revoke a license if the licensee has been found guilty and/or pled guilty in a court of competent jurisdiction to felonies involving prescribing, selling, administering, dispensing, mixing or otherwise preparing a prescription drug, including a controlled substance under state or federal law, for other than generally accepted therapeutic purposes. In 2022, Dr. Gosien submitted an application to the Board to reactivate his revoked West Virginia license. At the March 12, 2023 Complaint Committee meeting, the Committee received and reviewed information related to Dr. Gosien's criminal conviction. At the March 13, 2023 Board meeting, the Board unanimously voted to accept the recommendation of the Complaint Committee to provisionally deny Dr. Gosien's application for reactivation of his revoked license. On March 30, 2023, the Board sent correspondence to Dr. Gosien advising him that it had

determined that he failed to meet his burden of satisfying the Board that he is qualified for licensure pursuant to W. Va. Code R. § 11-1A-4.14 (2022). Following receipt of the correspondence, Dr. Gosien requested an administrative hearing. The Board issued a *Notice of Hearing* setting the matter for public hearing on June 5, 2023. Dr. Gosien later elected to withdraw his request for an administrative hearing. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that Dr. Gosien's application for reactivation of the revoked West Virginia medical license previously issued to him, License Number 12476, be denied. Dr. Dockery seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business to consider, Dr. Dockery moved that the meeting adjourn. Dr. Devaraj seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.
