CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Devaraj moved that staff advise the requestor that the specific expert work he identified was permissible, and that expert opinion and expert testimony by physician assistants which do not involve clinical practice do not require an active practice notification. Rev. Harman seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

The Committee reviewed the June 26, 2015 licensure Consent Order of Tyson E. Bubnar, PA. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that the Committee determine that the terms have been satisfied and notify Mr. Bubnar that his period of probation has concluded. Mr. Wooton seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
