Board Meeting Minutes July 15, 2024

The West Virginia Board of Medicine met at 9:00 am on Monday, July 15, 2024 at the Board Office.

With a quorum of members present, Dr. Sheth called the meeting to order, and attendance was documented by Ms. Frame.

CALL TO ORDER In order to minimize interruptions, Dr. Sheth asked all members to silence their cell

phones.

Dr. Sheth welcomed former board member Kishore K. Challa, MD, FACC, to the meeting. On behalf of the Board, Dr. Sheth presented Dr. Challa with a plaque in recognition of his many years of outstanding dedication and service made to the Board, including his service as President of the Board and Chair of several committees, including the Complaint Committee, and in appreciation of his commitment to protecting the quality and safety of medical and podiatric care for the citizens of West Virginia. Dr. Challa conveyed his gratitude to board and staff members.

Dr. Challa left the meeting room at this time and was not present for the remainder of the meeting.

Dr. Sheth announced that the election of officers will take place later this morning; therefore, this will conclude his term as President of the Board. He thanked board and staff members for their support during his tenure.

Prior to today's meeting, the draft May 20, 2024 meeting minutes were made available for members to review. Mr. Wooton moved that the meeting minutes be approved as presented. Dr. Kukkillaya seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Spangler thanked board and staff members for their commitment and engagement during the weekend committee meetings.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Mr. Spangler acknowledged the work of board staff during the 2024 renewal period, which concluded on June 28, 2024.

Mr. Spangler reported that Administrators in Medicine (AIM) offers several certification programs, and has recently developed a Certified Medical Board Licensing Specialist (CMBLS) Program. Mr. Spangler further reported that Sara J. Fields, Licensure Analyst for providers whose last names begin with the letters A through G, will be traveling to Maine next week to finalize her participation in the program and become a CMBLS.

Mr. Spangler reported that he will be attending the Administrators in Medicine Fall Workshop, which will be held in conjunction with the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission meeting, in Phoenix, Arizona on November 20-22, 2024.

Mr. Spangler thanked Dr. Sheth for his steadfast leadership during his tenure as President of the Board.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Executive/Management Committee met yesterday, July 14, 2024, at which time Mr. Spangler reported that as of May 12, 2024, twelve states, including West Virginia, have enacted legislation related to the Physician Assistant Licensure Compact. At the Committee's invitation, Ms. Takubo attended the meeting and provided a brief overview of the Compact and reported that each member state will need to appoint a commissioner to represent their state. The Committee recommended that the Board of Medicine, in conjunction with the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine, appoint Ms. Alley to represent West Virginia on the Physician Assistant Licensure Compact Commission. The motion of the Committee was given by Ms. Takubo, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee considered a request from Mujhtuba Ali Hassan Baksh, MD for sponsorship to sit for Step 3 of the United States Medical Licensure Exam (USMLE) for a final time. The USMLE allows candidates four attempts to successfully pass any step of the exam sequence and may permit a final attempt with board sponsorship. Dr. Baksh is currently a resident of Charleston, West Virginia, and holds an educational permit issued by this Board. Based upon all of the facts and information

EXECUTIVE / MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT available, the Committee recommended that the Board sponsor Dr. Baksh to take Step 3 of the USMLE. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee reviewed and approved the fiscal reports and purchasing card transactions for April and May 2024. The Board continues to maintain a good financial position.

Dr. Sheth reported that the September 9, 2024 board meeting will begin at 8:30 am to provide adequate time for a scheduled in-service by the Executive Director of the Ohio Medical Board. The in-service will focus on the investigation and evaluation of sexual misconduct complaints and trauma-informed training. This is an important training, and the Executive/Management Committee encouraged all members to participate.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee received an update regarding 2024 renewal. A renewal update will be provided later this morning as part of the Licensure Committee Report.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Board is in the process of renewing the contract with its current database vendor, Big Picture. It is anticipated that the database and the website will be placed out for bid in late summer or early fall.

Prior to today's meeting a copy of the proposed invoice in the matter of West Virginia Board of Medicine, Petitioner, v. Phillip Allen Peterson, MD, Respondent, Complaint No. 22-86-W, was made available for members to review. Dr. Sheth reported that in April 2024, the Board issued a Final Decision and Order in this matter, which is currently being appealed. Among other things, the Final Decision and Order required Dr. Peterson to pay the costs and expenses of the proceeding. The Committee recommended that the Board approve issuance of the invoice in this matter and delegate authority to board staff to respond to any request to stay payment pending appeal. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Sheth reported that in March 2024, the Board approved the issuance of an invoice in the matter of *West Virginia Board of Medicine, Petitioner*, v. *David Nathaniel Smith, MD, Respondent*, Complaint No. 21-96-W, which assessed Dr. Smith the costs and expenses of the proceeding. Dr. Smith has not paid the costs and expenses of the hearing as required by the Board's Final Decision and Order. The Board has sought the West Virginia Attorney General's assistance in resolving this issue.

Prior to today's meeting, a draft Joint Advisory Opinion Regarding Retail IV Therapy Issued by the West Virginia Board of Medicine, the West Virginia Board of Osteopathic Medicine, the West Virginia Board of Pharmacy and the West Virginia Board of Registered Nurses was made available for members to review. The Committee recommended that the Board approve the Joint Advisory Opinion as presented and authorize board staff to collaborate with the Board of Osteopathic Medicine, the Board of Pharmacy and the Board of Registered Nurses to finalize the opinion. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Sheth reported that the Committee reviewed correspondence inquiring about laser tattoo removal and directed board staff to respond and refer the inquirer to the Board's Public Policy Statement on Surgery Using Laser, Pulsed Light, Radiofrequency Devices, or Other Techniques.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Executive/Management Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Sheth, and the motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Foster reported that a hearing convened in December 2023 in the matter of West Virginia Board of Medicine, Petitioner, v. Phillip Allen Peterson, MD, Respondent, Complaint No. 22-86-W. On April 12, 2024, the Board entered a Final Decision and Order

BOARD ATTORNEY REPORT with regard to this matter. Counsel for Dr. Peterson has filed an appeal to the Intermediate Court of Appeals, which remains pending at this time.

Ms. Takubo reported that the Physician Assistant Committee met on Saturday, July 13, 2024. Ms. Takubo asked members to review the list of physician assistants up for action, and to advise of any conflicts. No conflicts were declared. The Committee recommended that each of the following fifty-two applicants be approved for initial physician assistant licensure:

Dr. Patel reported that the Committee met on Saturday, July 13, 2024, at which time two of the three scheduled applicants appeared before the Committee to discuss their licensure applications.

Dr. Mullins reported that on July 14, 2024, in association with an ongoing matter, the Committee reviewed certified court records in the matter of *United States of America vs. Thomas Romano*, Case No. 2:19-CR-202, regarding licensee Thomas James Romano, MD, License Number 13078. The Committee referred these records to the Board for review and possible action pursuant to West Virginia Code § 30-3-14(d), which imposes a nondiscretionary duty upon the Board to revoke a license if the licensee has been found guilty and/or pled guilty in a court of competent jurisdiction to any felony involving prescribing, selling, administering, dispensing, mixing or otherwise preparing a prescription drug, including a controlled substance under state or federal law, for other than generally accepted

therapeutic purposes. In advance of today's meeting, a proposed Order of Revocation and the supporting court records were made available for members to review on the cloud. The Complaint Committee recommended that the Board determine that:

- a. The Board received sufficient proof, pursuant to W. Va. Code § 30-3-14(d), to determine that Dr. Romano has been found guilty in a court of competent jurisdiction of 24 felony counts of unlawful distributing and dispensing of controlled substances, in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1), b(1)(C) and 18 U.S.C. § 2; and
- b. Dr. Romano's conviction of 24 felony counts of unlawful distribution and dispensing of controlled substances constitute felonies involving prescribing, selling, administering, dispensing, mixing or otherwise preparing a prescription drug, including a controlled substance under state or federal law, for other than generally accepted therapeutic purposes.

The Committee further recommended that the Board revoke Dr. Romano's West Virginia medical license, License No. 13078, effective upon entry of the Order. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Mullins, and the motion carried without opposition.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Complaint Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Mullins, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Patel reported that the Nominating Committee met on June 26, 2024 and July 12, 2024 to develop a slate of nominees for the offices of President and Vice President of the Board. The Committee's work was complicated by the fact that it had excellent candidates to consider. The Committee thanked all who expressed interest in serving in these roles. After much deliberation, the Committee's agreed upon slate of nominees are Jonathan P. Lilly, MD for President and Vicotria L. Takubo, PA-C for Vice President. Dr. Sheth opened the floor for additional nominations. No additional nominations were

declared. Dr. Lilly was elected as President and Ms. Takubo as Vice President by acclimation. Board members congratulated Dr. Lilly and Ms. Takubo on their election.

Dr. Patel reported that it is customary for the change of offices to take effect the day following the election; therefore, the change will become effective tomorrow, July 16, 2024.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Nominating Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Patel, and the motion carried without opposition.
