CALL TO

ORDER Dr. Mullins called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL

OF

MINUTES Ms. Mayfield made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 14, 2024 Complaint Committee meeting and the August 14, 2024 Emergency meeting. Dr. Kukkillaya seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

BOARD

COUNSEL REPORT Mr. Foster provided an update with respect to the Consent Orders offered by the Committee. Since the July meeting, a fully executed Consent Order has been entered with respect to each of the following licensees:

Govindbhai Mafatlal Patel, MD Complaint No. 24-09-W	August 15, 2024	This licensee was publicly reprimanded for his unprofessional conduct and required to complete a CME course on civility and communication.
Naeem Akhtar Qazi, MD Complaint No. 24-54-W	August 15, 2024	This licensee was fined \$500.00 for failing to complete a Board approved CME course on drug diversion training and best practice prescribing of controlled substances training.
Mansoor Ahmad Raja, MD Complaint No. 23-123-W	July 29, 2024	This licensee's medical license was suspended but the suspension was immediately stayed, and his license placed on a 5-year probationary period with certain terms and conditions. He was also publicly reprimanded for his dishonorable, unprofessional and/or unethical conduct.
Kim Steven Wiley, MD Complaint No. 24-62-W	August 15, 2024	This licensee was fined \$500.00 for failing to disclose a medical malpractice settlement in association with his 2023 licensure renewal application.

Joseph Henry Yanta, MD Complaint No. 23-106-W	July 15, 2024	This licensee is prohibited from practicing medicine and surgery until he satisfies certain terms and conditions to lift the restriction.
Jacob Andrew Young, MD Complaint No. 24-10-W	August 15, 2024	This licensee's medical license was placed in a six-month probationary status with certain terms and conditions, required to complete a CME course on professional boundaries, and was publicly reprimanded for violating the boundaries of a physician-patient relationship.

EXECUTIVE

SESSION Mr. Tipton made a motion that the Public Session be recessed in order to enter into Executive Session pursuant to W. Va. Code § 6-9A-4(b)(4) and (6), and West Virginia Code § 30-3-6 to discuss pre-probable cause disciplinary matters, matters effecting a license, and information that, if disclosed, would constitute an unwarranted invasion of privacy. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that the Committee initiate Complaint No. 24-91-W. Mr. Tipton seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Having completed the matter in which Dr. Mullins declared a conflict, Dr. Mullins returned to the meeting room for the remainder of the meeting.
