PAs who hold licenses which expired on March 31, 2025 are eligible to apply for reinstatement until March 31, 2026. There were no reinstatement applications processed in April 2025.

The Committee received an update on the PA Compact. The PA Compact Commission held its annual meeting on April 25, 2025, in Seattle, Washington. The PA Compact has received interim funding from its ex-officio partners, the AAPA and NCCPA, which will support the Compact as implementation continues. The PA Compact has received educational presentations from database providers, and will be moving forward with rulemaking throughout the summer.

Mr. Spangler provided an update on legislation that may affect the PA profession, including the Uniform Professional and Occupational Licensing Act of 2025. The Committee discussed the utility of Practice Notifications in the current practice climate, including the origin of Practice Notifications and how PA practice has transformed in the last decade. Dr. Devaraj moved that the Committee recommend to the Executive/Management Committee that the Board pursue the elimination of the Practice Notification process. Dr. Patel seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
