With a quorum of members present, Dr. Lilly called the meeting to order.

**CALL TO
ORDER**

In order to minimize interruptions, Dr. Lilly asked all members to silence their cell phone.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

Dr. Lilly reported that Ashish P. Sheth, MD's term on the Board officially expired on September 30, 2024. However, Board members are permitted to continue to serve until a successor is appointed. Governor Morrisey appointed a successor last week, marking the conclusion of Dr. Sheth's service on the Board. The Board extends its sincere appreciation to Dr. Sheth for his contributions and dedicated service throughout his tenure. He will be formally recognized at an upcoming meeting

Dr. Lilly welcomed Kishore K. Challa, MD, FACC, who was recently appointed to the Board. Dr. Challa is a cardiologist who practices in Charleston, West Virginia, with a long history of service on the Board. He was first appointed in 2013 by Governor Earl Ray Tomblin and was reappointed in 2017 by Governor Jim Justice. Dr. Challa previously served on the Board until May 2024. We are pleased to welcome Dr. Challa back and look forward to his continued insight and dedication to the Board.

Dr. Lilly welcomed Peter S. Martin, MD. Dr. Martin has served as Interim State Health Officer since February 2025; as such, he serves as Secretary of the Board of Medicine. Dr. Lilly reported that Dr. Martin has attended several meetings virtually, however, it is a pleasure for him to be able to join the meeting in person with us this morning.

Prior to today's meeting, the draft May 5, 2025 meeting minutes were made available for members to review. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that the May 5, 2025 meeting minutes be approved as presented. Mr. Wooton seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Spangler thanked board and staff members for their commitment and engagement during the weekend committee meetings.

Mr. Spangler reported that he recently underwent knee replacement surgery. He expressed his appreciation to board and staff members for their support during his recovery.

Mr. Spangler reported that in November 2025 the annual Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission meeting and the Administrator's in Medicine fall workshop will be held in Denver, Colorado.

Mr. Spangler reported that the Federation of State Medical Boards annual meeting will be held on April 30, 2026 – May 2, 2026 in Baltimore, Maryland. Mr. Spangler encouraged all members who are able to attend the meeting to plan to do so.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Executive/Management Committee met yesterday, July 13, 2025, at which time the Committee reviewed and approved the fiscal reports and purchasing card transactions for April and May 2025. The Board continues to maintain a good financial position.

Dr. Lilly reported that Committee reviewed draft guidance issued by the Advisory Commission on Additional Licensing Models, which relates to the assessment and supervision of internationally trained physicians during their provisional licensure period before they become eligible for a full unrestricted license to practice medicine. Board staff will explore alternate licensing models for international medical graduates and present recommendations to the Committee at a future meeting.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Board is currently accepting written comments on proposed amendments to W. Va. Code R. § 11-1B-1 *et seq.*, *Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants*, and W. Va. Code R. § 11-6-1 *et seq.*, *Continuing Education for Physicians and*

Podiatric Physicians. The amendments update the continuing education requirements for medical doctors, podiatric physicians and physician assistants. The comment period will conclude at 4:30 pm on July 24, 2025, after which the Legislative Committee will meet to consider the comments that are received. As the Legislative Committee did not meet this weekend, the Committee Executive / Management Committee recommended that the Board delegate authority to the Legislative Committee to act on behalf of the Board with regard to rulemaking. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Lilly reported that Board staff provided the Committee with an overview of the Universal Professional and Occupational Licensing Act (UPOLA) of 2025. UPOLA provides a pathway to licensure, registration or certification to eligible practitioners who either establish residency in West Virginia or who are married to an active-duty member of the armed forces of the United States and have accompanied the member to an official permanent change of station to a military installation located in West Virginia. A credential issued by the Board pursuant to the UPOLA pathway may not form the basis of participation in any interstate licensing compact. Additionally, because the UPOLA pathway does not include verification of education, the Board of Medicine profile for UPOLA licensees will denote that education is not primary source verified. If the proposed UPOLA licensure processes are approved by the Board, Board staff will issue a license or credential to a UPOLA applicant within three business days of determination that a complete application has been submitted by an eligible and qualified applicant and that the application does not contain unusual circumstances or discrepant information requiring personal review by the Board.

Dr. Lilly reported that W. Va. Code R. § 11-9-1 *et seq.*, *Certification, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Radiologist Assistants*, which became effective July 1, 2008, authorizes the Board to issue a certification to individuals that the Board approves to serve as radiologist assistants (RAs). To date, the Board has not issued a certification for this credential type. The Committee considered correspondence that was received from the West Virginia Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology

Board of Examiners inquiring whether the Board of Medicine would be amenable to introduce legislation to transfer the regulation of RAs to the Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners. The Committee recommended that the Board not oppose the introduction of legislation by the Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners to transfer the regulation of RAs from this Board to that Board; however, the Board of Medicine cannot introduce such legislation on behalf of the Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Prior to today's meeting a copy of the following draft documents were made available for members to review: (1) Initial Radiologist Assistant Certification Application and Instructions for Traditional Pathway Applicants; (2) Initial Radiologist Assistant Certification Application and Instructions for UPOLA Applicants; and (3) Radiologist Assistant Job Description. Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered a process for radiologist assistants applying for initial certification via the traditional pathway and the UPOLA pathway. The Committee recommended that the Board approve the processes as presented. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received a report from staff regarding the International Association of Medical Regulatory Authorities (IAMRA), which is a membership organization that promotes effective medical regulation worldwide by supporting best practice, innovation, collaboration, and knowledge sharing in the interest of public safety and in support of the medical profession. IAMRA's vision is that "everyone around the world is treated and cared for by safe and competent doctors." The Committee recommended that the Board become a member of IAMRA. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee directed Board staff to research options for virtual participation in Board and Committee meetings. The Committee will review virtual meeting options and consider development of a formal policy at a future meeting.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an update from Board staff regarding licensure compacts.

- North Carolina recently became the 44th state to join the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC) and IMLC legislation is currently pending in Massachusetts. Additionally, effective July 7, 2025, physicians can designate Pennsylvania as their state of principal licensure, which means that the Pennsylvania State Board of Medicine may issue Letters of Qualification.
- Iowa has introduced legislation to enact the Interstate Podiatric Medical Licensure Compact.
- An update regarding the Physician Assistant Compact will be provided later this morning as part of the Physician Assistant Committee Report.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an update from Board staff regarding the 2025 renewal period. A renewal update will be provided later this morning as part of the Licensure Committee Report.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Board's contract with the current database vendor Albertson Consulting / Big Picture concluded on July 10, 2025. An emergency contract is currently in place. Board staff continue to work with the West Virginia Purchasing Division to procure a new database and website. The Request for Proposal has been submitted, and Evaluation Committee membership has been established. The Board is currently in what the West Virginia Purchasing Division refers to as a "Blackout" period, which prohibits the Board from engaging in conversation with potential database vendors.

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Executive/Management Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Mr. Foster reported that the docket is currently clear, with no matters pending appeal.
