Call to Order

With a quorum of members present, Dr. Lilly called the meeting to order.

Announcements

In order to minimize interruptions, Dr. Lilly asked members to silence their cell phones.

Dr. Lilly welcomed and introduced newly appointed board member, Abdul R. Zanabli, MD, who is a nephrologist and hypertension specialist that practices in the Charleston area. The Board looks forward to working with Dr. Zanabli.

Dr. Lilly reported that Dr. Zanabli succeeds David A. Mullins, MD, who served on the Board since 2016. The Board appreciates Dr. Mullins' service to the Board and wishes him all the best in his future endeavors. Dr. Mullins will be recognized at a future meeting.

Dr. Lilly welcomed former board member, Ashish P. Sheth, MD, to the meeting and presented him with this plaque in recognition of his many years of outstanding dedication and service made to the West Virginia Board of Medicine, including service as President of the Board and Chair of several committees, and in appreciation of his commitment to protecting the quality and safety of medical and podiatric care for the citizens of West Virginia. Dr. Sheth expressed his appreciation to board members and staff.

Dr. Sheth left the meeting at this time.

Approval of Minutes

Prior to today's meeting, a copy of the draft September 8, 2025 meeting minutes were made available for members to review. Dr. Challa moved that the September 8, 2025 meeting minutes be approved as presented. Dr. Dockery seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

Executive Director's Report

Mr. Spangler reported that he will be traveling to Denver, Colorado to attend the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Commission meeting on November 17-18, 2025 and the Administrators in Medicine Fall Workshop on November 19, 2025.

Mr. Spangler reported that board members may have recently received correspondence from a concerned citizen which reports a potential complaint matter. Mr. Spangler reminded members of the importance of not engaging with individuals directly, as doing so may create a conflict of interest which would prohibit them from deliberating in the matter should it come before the Board in the future. Mr. Spangler further advised that if members receive correspondence related to Board of Medicine matters, the correspondence should be forwarded to the Board Office.

Executive / Management Committee Report

Fiscal Reports and Purchasing Card Transactions

Dr. Lilly reported that the Executive / Management Committee met yesterday, November 9, 2025, at which time the Committee reviewed and approved the fiscal reports and purchasing card transactions for the months of August and September 2025. The Board continues to maintain a good financial position.

Inquiry Regarding Requirements for Independent Contractors Working for a Veterans Affairs Hospital

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered correspondence which inquired whether teleradiologists who are independent contractors working for the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) need to obtain a West Virginia medical license to interpret images exclusively for VA facilities located in West Virginia. The Committee directed Board staff to respond to the inquirer and provide that nothing in the West Virginia Medical Practice Act exempts federal contractors, as opposed to federal employees, from licensure in West Virginia if they are practicing in this state.

Consideration of an Inquiry Regarding Licensure Eligibility for Canadian Medical Graduates Pre- and Post- July 1, 2025

Dr. Lilly reported that effective July 1, 2025 Canadian medical schools ceased being accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME) and began being solely accredited by the Committee on Accreditation of Canadian Medical Schools (CACMS). Pursuant to W. Va. Code §30-3-10(b), the Board is authorized to accept medical education for applicants who have “graduated and received the degree of doctor of medicine or its equivalent from a school of medicine located within the United States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or Canada and is approved by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education or by the board.” The Committee recommended that the Board accept education from Canadian Medical Schools that are accredited by the CACMS. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Discussion and/or Action Regarding the Use of Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare

Dr. Lilly reported that some states have begun introducing legislation to regulate the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in healthcare. At this time, Board staff will continue to monitor the regulation of the use of AI in healthcare and will keep the Committee apprised.

Request for the Board to Email a Survey Link to Credential Holders on Behalf of the West Virginia Office of Epidemiology and Prevention Services

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered a request from the West Virginia Office of Epidemiology and Prevention Services asking that the Board email a survey link to Board of Medicine credential holders. The survey relates to antimicrobial resistance. The Committee

authorized Board staff to email the survey link to credential holders on behalf of the Office of Epidemiology and Prevention Services

Consideration of Proposed Amendments to Federation of State Medical Boards Bylaws

Dr. Lilly reported that the Federation of State Medical Boards (FSMB) bylaws currently prohibit staff fellows, such as the Executive Director of a medical board, from being elected as an officer. Proposed modifications to the FSMB bylaws are currently being discussed among state licensing boards. The Committee recommended that the Board propose that the FSMB conduct a study resolution to determine whether staff fellows should be permitted to hold an officer position. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Licensure Compact Update

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an update from staff regarding licensure compacts.

The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC) continues to expand.

The Interstate Podiatric Medical Compact (IPMC) is beginning to be introduced in legislatures throughout the country. West Virginia may seek introduction of IPMC legislation in 2027.

An update regarding the PA Compact will be provided later this morning as part of the Physician Assistant Committee Report.

Update Regarding Licensure via the Universal Professional and Occupational Licensing Act of 2025

Dr. Lilly reminded members that the Universal Professional and Occupational Licensing Act of 2025 (UPOLA) allows an individual to be granted a license, registration or certificate in West Virginia if they hold an equivalent credential in another state, in the same discipline and at the same practice level and meet all other requirements prescribed by law. At the September 7, 2025 meeting, the Committee considered correspondence which inquired whether a physician licensed in Puerto Rico is eligible for licensure via the UPOLA pathway. At the Committee's direction, Board staff sought the opinion of the West Virginia Attorney General's Office with regard to this matter. The Attorney General's Office has advised that territories such as Puerto Rico are included in the statutory meaning of the code section; thus applicants who hold a credential in Puerto Rico are eligible to apply for a credential in West Virginia via the UPOLA pathway. Board staff will notify the inquirer of such.

Update in the Matter of *Hil Rizvi v. Mark Spangler, Director – West Virginia Board of Medicine, CC-14-2025-C-AP-1*

Dr. Lilly reminded members that the matter of *Hil Rizvi v. Mark Spangler, Director – West Virginia Board of Medicine, CC-14-2025-C-AP-1* relates to an expired application for relicensure. Mr. Anthony Eates of the West Virginia Attorney General's Office represented the Board in this matter, which was dismissed on jurisdictional grounds. Following dismissal, the

plaintiff appealed the decision to the Circuit Court of Hampshire County, West Virginia. The Circuit Court has dismissed the matter.

Update Regarding Technology Upgrades

Dr. Lilly reported that Grandview Systems Inc. was awarded the contract to install new technology in the boardroom and the small conference room. It is anticipated that installation will commence in the coming weeks.

Update Regarding Procurement of a New Database and Website

Dr. Lilly reported that Board staff continue to work with the West Virginia Purchasing Division to procure a new database. The Request for Proposal has been published, and vendor questions have been submitted to the Board for response. The Board remains in what the Purchasing Division refers to as a “Blackout Period” which prohibits the Board from engaging in conversation with any potential database vendor.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Executive / Management Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Legislative Committee Report

Board of Medicine Rules

Dr. Challal reported that the Legislative Committee met yesterday, November 9, 2025, at which time Mr. Spangler reported that the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee has approved the proposed amendments to W. Va. Code § 11-1B-1 *et seq.*, *Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants*, and W. Va. Code § 11-6-1 *et seq.*, *Continuing Education Requirements for Physicians and Podiatric Physicians*, without modification. The rules will be considered by the West Virginia Legislature during the 2026 session.

Consideration Regarding the Creation of an Emeritus or Licensure Designation

Dr. Challal reported that at the direction of the Committee, Board staff have researched emeritus / retirement licensure in other states and have begun drafting a proposed bill which would authorize the Board to issue, without a fee, an emeritus status license to a practitioner who holds a current, valid license issued by the board, has practiced in West Virginia for ten years and has fully retired from practice with no pending complaints or disqualifying discipline. The bill would also provide a limited window for prior retirees to request an emeritus status license and rulemaking authority to govern standards. The Committee recommended that the Board approve proceeding with a bill for development of an emeritus license as described and delegate authority to Board staff to make non-substantive changes as the final draft is completed. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challal, and the motion carried without opposition.

Potential 2026 Legislative Topics

Dr. Challa reminded members that during the 2025 legislative session, at the request of the Board, a bill was introduced to modify the West Virginia Medical Practice Act and permit the Board to license and regulate genetic counselors. The bill was not placed on an agenda for consideration. The Committee recommended that the Board authorize the following modifications to the proposed bill that was previously approved by the Board:

- Reincorporating the existing alternate licensure pathway for international medical graduates, which was previously amended out of the Medical Practice Act in the earlier draft bill, with a modification to require that international medical graduate applicants with acceptable unaccredited training submit a letter of sponsorship from the proposed employing institution.
- Updating the definition of “State Health Officer” as defined in W. Va. Code § 16-1-5, *State health officer; Commissioner of the Bureau for Public Health; appointment; qualifications; term*, to compliment changes made to W. Va. Code § 16-1-5.
- Allowing the Board discretion to license applicants who took more than ten years to complete all steps of the United States Medical Licensure Examination (USMLE) if the applicant is currently certified by an American Board of Medical Specialties member board.

The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Challa reported that West Virginia University has established a podiatric medicine and surgery residency program and there is an interest for the Board of Medicine to establish an educational permit for podiatric physicians. The Committee recommended that the Board authorize staff to draft proposed legislation which would establish an educational permit for podiatric physicians. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Dr. Challa reported that it may be necessary to hold an interim meeting to consider legislative matters between now and the January 2026 meeting. It is customary for the Board to delegate authority to the Legislative Committee to act on behalf of the Board as necessary to legislative matters at interim meetings. As such, the Committee recommended that the Board delegate authority to the Legislative Committee to act on behalf of the Board as necessary with regard to legislative matters between now and the January 12, 2026 board meeting. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Legislative Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Physician Assistant Compact Update
