Call to Order

With a quorum of members present, Dr. Lilly called the meeting to order.

Announcements

In order to minimize interruptions, Dr. Lilly asked members to silence their cell phones.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Federation of State Medical Boards Annual Meeting will be held on April 30 – May 2, 2026 in Baltimore, Maryland. All members who are able to attend the meeting are encouraged to do so. Dr. Lilly encouraged members who are interested in attending the meeting to see Mr. Spangler or Ms. Frame at the conclusion of today's meeting.

Dr. Lilly reminded members that the deadline to file Financial Disclosure Statements with the West Virginia Ethics Commission is February 2, 2026.

Approval of Minutes

Prior to today's meeting, a copy of the draft November 10, 2025 meeting minutes were made available for members to review. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that the November 10, 2025 meeting minutes be approved as presented. Dr. Patel seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

Executive Director's Report

Mr. Spangler thanked board and staff members for their commitment and dedication during the weekend committee meetings.

Mr. Spangler recognized board and staff members who represent West Virginia at a national level and encouraged all members to consider serving in some capacity at a national level.

Executive / Management Committee Report

Fiscal Reports and Purchasing Card Transactions

Dr. Lilly reported that the Executive / Management Committee met yesterday, January 11, 2026, at which time the Committee reviewed and approved the fiscal reports and purchasing card transactions for the months of October and November 2025. The Board continues to maintain a good financial position.

Results of the 2025 Purchasing Review Conducted by the WV Purchasing Division

Dr. Lilly reported that in November 2025 the Board underwent a purchasing review conducted by the West Virginia Purchasing Division. The review identified two minor compliance

occurrences, specifically certain reportable assets were appropriately tagged and inventoried, but the related data was not recorded in the West Virginia Oasis system, which has been corrected, and a cloud service license was purchased without obtaining prior approval by the West Virginia Office of Technology. No further corrective action is required. Board staff will continue to attend purchasing division trainings and stay up to date on purchasing requirements to ensure continued compliance.

Consideration of Modifications Related to the Delivery Method for Initial Licenses Issued by the Board

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee authorized Board staff to discontinue the use of certified mail for the purpose of mailing wall licenses to new licensees.

Consideration of Proposed PA Compact Rules

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an update from Board staff regarding two proposed PA Compact Rules – *Compact Privilege* and *Compact Data System, Confidentiality and Information Sharing*. The Compact Commission is currently accepting public comments with regard to the rules.

Concerns Regarding Office Doors / Security

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received a report from Board staff regarding office security. Thereafter, the Committee directed Board staff to convey the security concerns to the landlord and to move forward with obtaining quotes for security cameras. Additionally, the Committee authorized the Executive Director to move forward with security upgrades as necessary.

Licensure Compact Update

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an update from staff regarding licensure compacts.

The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact (IMLC) continues to expand.

The Interstate Podiatric Medical Compact (IPMC) is beginning to be introduced in legislatures throughout the country. West Virginia may seek introduction of IPMC legislation in 2027.

An update regarding the PA Compact will be provided later this morning as part of the Physician Assistant Committee Report.

Update Regarding the Possible Unauthorized Practice of Medicine by an Individual who is not Licensed by the West Virginia Board of Medicine

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee directed Board staff to engage in the investigation of whether the unauthorized practice of medicine is occurring at a business that was initially located in St. Albans but has relocated to another location in Kanawha County.

Update Regarding a Proposed Business Entity Name Which Contains Medical Terminology but does not Meet the Requirements for Authorization by the Board

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an inquiry related to the naming of a business entity and requested that staff follow up to obtain additional information. Based upon additional information that was received, the Committee elected to refer this matter to the Complaint Committee for evaluation of whether or not a complaint and investigation process is warranted regarding the involved licensee.

Update in the Matter of Hil Rizvi v. Mark Sapngler, Director – West Virginia Board of Medicine, CC-14-2025-C-AP-1

Dr. Lilly reminded members that the matter of *Hil Rizvi v. Mark Spangler, Director – West Virginia Board of Medicine, CC-14-2025-C-AP-1* relates to an expired application for relicensure. Mr. Anthony Eates of the West Virginia Attorney General's Office represented the Board in this matter, which was dismissed on jurisdictional grounds. Following dismissal, the plaintiff appealed the decision to the Circuit Court of Hampshire County, West Virginia. The Circuit Court dismissed the matter. Dr. Rizvi has appealed the matter to the West Virginia Intermediate Court of Appeals. The deadline to appeal to be perfected was January 6, 2026.

Update Regarding Technology Upgrades

Dr. Lilly reported that new technology has been installed in the boardroom and the conference room. The Complaint Committee utilized the new system during its meeting yesterday, and advised that it is a significant improvement over the former system.

Update Regarding Procurement of a New Database and Website

Dr. Lilly reported that Board staff continue to work with the West Virginia Purchasing Division to procure a new database. The Request for Proposal closed on December 17, 2025. The Board received proposals from eight vendors. It is anticipated that proposals will be evaluated in the coming weeks.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Executive / Management Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Legislative Committee Report

Board of Medicine Rules and Proposed Bills

Dr. Challa reported that the Legislative Committee met yesterday, January 11, 2026, at which time Mr. Spangler reported that the 2026 Legislative Session will commence on Wednesday, January 14, 2026. During the session, the Legislature will consider proposed amendments to W. Va. Code § 11-1B-1 *et seq.*, *Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants*, and W. Va. Code § 11-6-1 *et seq.*,

Continuing Education Requirements for Physicians and Podiatric Physicians. The rules will be considered by the West Virginia Legislature during the 2026 session. Additionally, Board staff have drafted bills to update the West Virginia Medical Practice Act, authorize the regulation of genetic counselors, establish an emeritus license for qualified providers and create an educational permit for podiatric physicians.

Committee Authorization to Act on Legislative Matters During the 2026 Regular Session of the West Virginia Legislature

Dr. Challa reported that the Committee plans to hold four interim meetings during the 2026 legislative session, with additional meetings to be scheduled as necessary to respond to legislative matters. The Committee recommended that the Board delegate authority to the Committee to act on behalf of the Board as necessary with regard to legislative matters between this meeting and the March 8, 2026 meeting. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Other Legislative Matters of Interest to the Committee

Dr. Challa reported that the Committee discussed the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee to develop policies and educational materials for licensees concerning the use of AI in healthcare. Dr. Challa encouraged all members who are interested in serving on the Ad Hoc Committee to see Mr. Spangler or Ms. Frame at the conclusion of today's meeting.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Legislative Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Physician Assistant Compact Update

Ms. Takubo reported that the Committee received an update from Board staff regarding the Physician Assistant Compact Commission. The Commission continues to meet regularly and has promulgated two rules for public comment. A Request for Proposal for a data system was published and responses have been submitted. The current target for issuance of practice privileges is 2027. The Compact continues to receive generous support from the American Academy of Physician Associates and the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants. Drafting of additional rules remains ongoing.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board grant the petition, convert Dr. Seifarth's medical school faculty license to a restricted license issued in extraordinary circumstances to practice pediatric surgery in the state of West Virginia. Additionally, the Committee recommended that the Board make the following findings:

1. Dr. Seifarth has exceptional education, training and practice credentials, including:
 - a. He has completed the following postgraduate training:

- b. He has held academic appointments at Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine of Case Western Reserve University, University of Washington, Pacific Northwest University of Health Sciences, and West Virginia University. He currently holds the positions of Associate Professor of Pediatrics and Associate Professor of Surgery at West Virginia University.

- c. Dr. Seifarth has practiced pediatric surgery in the United States since 2009. Since March of 2021, he has served as Surgeon-in-Chief and Division Chief Pediatric Surgery at WVU Medicine Children's Hospital in Morgantown, West Virginia. He recently served as the Surgical Director of Pediatric Intensive Care Unit and Trauma Director Pediatric Surgery at WVU Medicine Children's Hospital. Additionally, he currently practices as a Consultant Pediatric Surgeon for nationwide Children's Hospital in Columbus, Ohio. Previously, he pioneered robotic and advanced minimally invasive techniques at the Cleveland Clinic, where he led their department and he also led a specialist team to build Montana's most comprehensive Children's Hospital.
 - d. West Virginia University favorably reports that within his tenure at WVU Dr. Seifarth has "built a high-end pediatric surgical practice of four pediatric surgeons—the largest and most sophisticated practice in the history of West Virginia" and reports that his "expertise is not only vital for our university but also for improving the health of children across our state and beyond."
 - e. He has received numerous honors and awards throughout his training, education and career, including awards for leadership, patient care and patient advocacy. A recent example is his receipt of the Cornerstone Award for exceptional care for trauma patients conferred by West Virginia University in October 2025 and;
 - f. Dr. Seifarth has authored or co-authored 51 peer reviewed articles and 13 book chapters.
2. Dr. Seifarth's practice in the state as a medical school faculty licensee has been beneficial to the public welfare, and expanding the geographic area in which he may practice will expand the benefit beyond the medical school campus of his faculty appointment.
 3. His specialty is pediatric surgery and there is a need for this specialty in West Virginia. West Virginia faces a critical shortage of pediatric surgeons, a circumstance that places children and families at risk of delayed or inaccessible care.
 4. Dr. Seifarth's education, training and practice credentials are substantially equivalent to the requirements of licensure established in W. Va. Code §30-3-10(b). While his education and initial training occurred outside of the United States and are not, standing alone, substantially equivalent to the licensure requirements in this state, his subsequent training, education and experience as detailed in these findings satisfy this requirement.
 5. Dr. Seifarth has no professional discipline which would render him ineligible for an extraordinary circumstances license.
 6. Dr. Seifarth is eligible for a restricted license in extraordinary circumstances.

Based upon these findings, the Committee recommended that the Board: (1) determine that Dr. Seifarth meets the criteria for a restricted license in extraordinary circumstances set forth in the West Virginia Medical Practice Act, W.Va. Code §30-3-10(e) and W. Va. Code R. §11-2-1 *et seq.* (2009); and (2) convert Dr. Seifarth's medical school faculty license to a restricted license issued in extraordinary circumstances to practice pediatric surgery in West Virginia. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Patel, and the motion carried without opposition.


