Call to Order

With a quorum of members present, Dr. Lilly called the meeting to order.

Announcements

In order to minimize interruptions, Dr. Lilly asked members to silence their cell phones.

Dr. Lilly welcomed former Board member, David A. Mullins, MD, who joined the meeting virtually. Dr. Mullins served as a member of the Board from 2016 until 2025. On behalf of the Board, Dr. Lilly presented Dr. Mullins with a plaque in recognition of his outstanding dedication and service to the Board. The Board wishes Dr. Mullins the best in his future endeavors.¹

Approval of Minutes

Prior to today's meeting, a copy of the draft January 12, 2026 meeting minutes were made available for members to review. Dr. Challa moved that the January 12, 2026 meeting minutes be approved as presented. Dr. Kukkillaya seconded the motion, and the motion carried without opposition.

Executive Director's Report

Mr. Spangler thanked board and staff members for their commitment and dedication during the weekend committee meetings.

Mr. Spangler reported with great sadness that the son of former long standing Board member, Reverend O. Richard Bowyer, recently passed away. Our thoughts are with the Bowyer family.

Mr. Spangler reported that he and Dr. Lilly recently attended the Federation of State Medical Boards Trauma Informed Training, which was held in Nashville, TN. The training was beneficial and raised important issues faced by medical boards as they investigate complaints.

Mr. Spangler reminded members that the 2026 Administrators in Medicine Annual Meeting (April 29, 2026) and the Federation of State Medical Boards Annual Meeting (April 30 – May 2, 2026) will be held in Baltimore, Maryland. Mr. Spangler encouraged any member who is interested in attending the meetings to see Ms. Frame or himself at the conclusion of today's meeting.

Executive/Management Committee Report

Fiscal Reports and Purchasing Card Transactions

Dr. Lilly reported that the Executive/Management Committee met yesterday, March 8, 2026, at which time the Committee reviewed and approved the fiscal reports and purchasing card transactions for the months of December 2025 and January 2026. The Board continues to maintain a good financial position.

Consideration of a Request for Opinion Regarding Virtual Direct Supervision for Contrast-Enhanced Imaging Procedures

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered a request that was received from the West Virginia Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board of Examiners which relates to supervision requirements for contrast-enhanced imaging procedures. The Committee directed Board staff to respond and advise that the Board of Medicine does not oppose aligning state supervision requirements for contrast-enhanced imaging procedures to allow virtual direct supervision which is consistent with the new Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services policy, namely that supervision be provided by a West Virginia licensed physician who is available in real time via two-way audio and video technology.

Consideration of American Podiatric Medical Licensing Examination Score Report Delivery Method

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered correspondence that was received from the Federation of Podiatric Medical Boards, which advises that the National Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners has enabled a new feature that permits candidates to email American Podiatric Medical Licensing Examination Score Reports to third parties. Additionally, the correspondence requests that the Board of Medicine advise as to how score reports will be accepted by this board. The Committee directed Board staff to respond that the West Virginia Board of Medicine prefers the current process which utilizes secure access via a website portal.

Consideration of Correspondence Received Relating to Professional Accountability

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered correspondence advocating for enhanced complaint procedures for detained persons. The Committee directed Board staff to thank the individual for raising concerns and for advocating for detained persons, and to advise of the Board's established complaint process.

Litigation Matter

Ohio County Commission, et al., v. Express Scripts, Inc. et al.

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee received an update from staff concerning a subpoena for records served upon the Board in the litigation matter of *Ohio County Commission, et al., v. Express Scripts, Inc. et al.*

Consideration of a Proposed Business Entity Name Which Contains Medical Terminology but does not Meet the Requirements for Authorization by the Board

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee considered an inquiry relating to the naming of a corporate entity. The Committee directed Board staff to advise the requesting entity and the West Virginia Secretary of State's Office that the Board does not oppose the business name, so long as the entity does not engage in any activity that constitutes the practice of medicine.

2026 Renewal

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee was advised by Board staff that the renewal period for medical doctors with lasts names that begin with the letters A through L, educational permits, controlled substance dispensing practitioner registrations for medical doctors whose lasts name begins with the letters A through L, and certificate of authorizations for professional limited liability companies will begin on May 6, 2026 and will conclude on June 30, 2026.

Update in the Matter of *Hil Rizvi v. West Virginia Board of Medicine Mark Spangler, Director, 25-ICA-453*

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee was advised by Board staff that the matter of *Hil Rizvi v. West Virginia Board of Medicine Mark Spangler, Director* was dismissed by the West Virginia Intermediate Court of Appeals.

Acceptable Meeting Modalities

Dr. Lilly reported that the Committee discussed meeting modalities. It is the continued expectation of the Executive/Management Committee that attending members should be present, in-person, at all meetings. If special circumstances arise which prohibit a member from attending a meeting in person, the member should contact Mr. Spangler and/or the Board President in a timely manner to discuss.

Procurement of New Database and Website

Dr. Lilly reported that Board staff continue to work with the West Virginia Purchasing Division to procure a new database. The *Request for Proposal* closed on December 17, 2025, oral presentations have concluded, and the Board's Evaluation Committee is in the process of scoring the proposals.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Executive/Management Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Lilly, and the motion carried without opposition.

Legislative Committee Report

Board of Medicine Rules

Dr. Challa reported that the 2026 session of the West Virginia Legislature convened on January 14, 2026 and will conclude on March 14, 2026. The Legislative Committee met on January 28, 2026, February 11, 2026, February 25, 2026 and yesterday, March 8, 2026.

Dr. Challa reported that the Board of Medicine rule bills include proposed amendments to W. Va. Code R. § 11-1B-1 *et seq.*, *Licensure, Practice Requirements, Disciplinary and Complaint Procedures, Continuing Education, Physician Assistants*, and W. Va. Code R. § 11-6-1 *et seq.*, *Continuing Education Requirements for Physicians and Podiatric Physicians*. The rule bills have been bundled into **House Bill 4265**. House Bill 4265 is on third reading on the Senate floor today, March 9, 2026.

Board of Medicine Bills

Dr. Challa reported that **Senate Bill 677** and **House Bill 5458** would update the West Virginia Medical Practice Act and authorize the Board to license and regulate genetic counselors. House Bill 5458 is on third reading on the Senate floor today, March 9, 2026. If this legislation passes and is enacted, this will be the culmination of three years' work by the members and leadership of this Board, our dedicated staff and the commitment of the lead sponsors of the bills, Senator Takubo and Delegate Rohrbach.

Dr. Challa reported that **Senate Bill 583** and **House Bill 5325** would create an emeritus status license. House Bill 5325 is on first reading on the Senate floor today, March 9, 2026.

Bills Introduced that Relate to the Regulation of Medicine and/or are of Potential Interest to the Board

Dr. Challa reported that the following bills have crossed from one chamber to the second and continue to be closely monitored by Board staff:

Bill Number	Title	Notes
Senate Bill 489	Relating to West Virginia Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists	Senate Bill 489 establishes licensure of master estheticians. The Committee opposes this bill to the extent that it would permit the practice of medicine.
Senate Bill 580	Updating Practice Act for West Virginia Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board	Among other things, Senate Bill 580 would authorize the West Virginia Imaging and Radiation Therapy Technology Board to assume licensure and regulation of radiologist assistants.

Senate Bill 956	Authorizing physician assistants to own a business	In addition to authorizing physician assistants to own foreign and domestic medical corporations and medical professional limited liability companies, Senate Bill 956 would remove collaborative / supervisory requirements and allow for independent practice. However, as currently drafted, the bill uses some antiquated concepts and does not directly address practice notifications. The Committee opposes this bill as drafted and is engaged in efforts to seek amendment in the House which addresses these concerns. This bill is on House Health and Human Resources Committee agenda today, March 9, 2026.
House Bill 4951	Requiring medical doctors and osteopathic physicians to complete continuing education	As currently drafted, House Bill 4951 would require physicians to complete a nutrition CME on their first renewal after July 1, 2026 or within twelve months of obtaining an initial West Virginia license.

Committee Authorization to Act on Behalf of the Board with Regard to Legislative Matters During the 2026 Session of the West Virginia Legislature

Dr. Challa reported that the Committee is scheduled to meet on Wednesday, March 11, 2026 at 5 pm. It is customary for the Board to delegate authority to the Legislative Committee to act on behalf of the Board as necessary regarding legislative matters at interim meetings. Dr. Challa advised that if the Board would like to delegate such authority to the Committee between today’s meeting and the May 18, 2026 Board meeting, the Board President could entertain a motion from the membership to that effect. Dr. Kukkillaya moved that the Board delegate authority to the Legislative Committee to act on behalf of the Board as necessary with regard to legislative matters between this meeting and the May 2026 meeting. Mr. Tipton seconded the motion and the motion carried without opposition.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Legislative Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Challa, and the motion carried without opposition.

Board Attorney Report

Mr. Foster reported that at the January meeting the Complaint Committee found probable cause to substantiate charges of disqualification under W. Va. Code § 30-3-14 with regard to David Mark Anderson, MD. It is anticipated that a *Complaint and Notice of Hearing* in this matter will be issued later this week.

Intestate Telehealth Registration Renewal Update

Ms. Takubo reported that Interstate Telehealth Registration renewal began on February 4, 2026 and will conclude on March 31, 2026. When renewal began, 29 physician assistant registrants were eligible to renew. As of March 5, 2026, 7 physician assistants have renewed and 21 have not yet completed the renewal process. Final numbers will be provided at the May meeting.

Physician Assistant Compact Update

Ms. Takubo reported that the Committee received an update from Board staff regarding the Physician Assistant Compact Commission. Twenty-one states have joined, and legislation has been introduced in twelve additional states. The Compact is advancing towards a contract for a database vendor and rulemaking is ongoing.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Physician Assistant Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Ms. Takubo, and the motion carried without opposition.

Licensure Committee Report

Applicant Appearances

Dr. Patel reported that the Licensure Committee met on Saturday, March 7, 2026, at which time two of the three scheduled physicians appeared before the Committee.

On August 17, 2022, Michael Antonio Reynolds, MD and the Board entered into a Consent Order which issued Dr. Reynolds a medical license and restricted his practice in West Virginia to the specialty of addiction medicine with additional terms and conditions, including participation in the West Virginia Medical Professionals Health Program and his maintenance and submission of controlled substance prescribing logs beginning on November 1, 2022. This was an annual appearance pursuant to the terms of Dr. Reynolds' Consent Order. No action was required.

Prior to today’s meeting, the reports reflecting the above licensure actions were made available for members to review. A copy of the reports are attached to these minutes as Attachment 4 and are incorporated herein by reference.

Other Committee Discussions

Dr. Patel reported that the Committee reviewed an inquiry concerning whether a pathologist practicing traditional pathology is eligible for an interstate telehealth registration. The Committee directed Board staff to advise the requestor that physical slide/specimen review does not constitute the practice of telehealth and therefore is not practice which would be authorized by an interstate telehealth registration.

Dr. Patel reported that the Committee discussed the proliferation of the use of digital signatures in the completion of application materials and confirmed that the executive director may exercise discretion in accepting digital signatures on licensure documents in circumstances where it is appropriate and when hallmarks of authenticity are present.

Dr. Patel reported that the Committee received an update from Board staff regarding licensing compacts. There are now 45 member states of the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact with New Mexico being the most recent to join. Michigan's participation in the compact is currently in jeopardy due to a legislative conflict currently in progress in the Michigan legislature. If not resolved by March 28, 2026, physicians who utilize Michigan as their state of principal licensure will have to make other arrangements to continue participation in the compact. Board staff are monitoring the situation and will engage in outreach to the approximately 150 affected West Virginia licensees, if needed. The Interstate Podiatric Licensure Compact may be introduced during the 2027 legislative session.

Dr. Patel reported that Interstate Telehealth Registration renewal began on February 4, 2026 and will conclude on March 31, 2026. When renewal began, 214 physician registrants were eligible to renew. As of March 5, 2026, 111 physicians have renewed and 103 have not yet completed the renewal process. Final numbers will be provided at the May meeting.

Acceptance and Ratification of Report

The Committee recommended that the Board accept and ratify the Licensure Committee Report. The motion of the Committee was given by Dr. Patel, and the motion carried without opposition.


