CONSENT ORDER

The West Virginia Board of Medicine ("Board") and Gauravi K. Majmundar, M.D., ("Dr. Majmundar") freely and voluntarily enter into the following Order pursuant to West Virginia Code §30-3-14(n):

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Dr. Majmundar currently holds a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of West Virginia, issued originally in 1989, and her address of record with the Board is in Charleston, West Virginia.

2. Dr. Majmundar's license is identified as West Virginia License No. 15832.

3. Dr. Majmundar has pleaded guilty to two (2) violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1341 (mail fraud), in the case United States of America v. Gauravi K. Majmundar, Case No. 2:97CR00022-001, in United States District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia, which violations are felonies.

4. Dr. Majmundar has expressed a desire to enter into this Consent Order in order to settle and terminate any dispute

with the Board as a result of her plea of guilty set forth in paragraph 3.

5. The conviction of a felony directly related to the practice of medicine is a serious crime requiring as a minimum sanction the suspension of a license to practice medicine.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Probable cause exists to substantiate charges of disqualification from the practice of medicine due to violations of West Virginia Code §30-3-14(c)(2), (5) and (17), and violations of West Virginia Legislative Rules, West Virginia Board of Medicine, 11 CSR 1A 12.1(e),(j), (k) and (p), all relating to being found guilty of a crime which is a felony and directly related to the practice of medicine, filing false reports, and unprofessional conduct.

2. The Board has determined that it is appropriate and in the public interest to waive the filing of charges in this matter and to settle and terminate any dispute with Dr. Majmundar based on her guilty plea, as set forth in paragraph 3 of the Findings of Fact, by entering into this Consent Order with Dr. Majmundar, and provided she complies with each and every term of this Consent Order.

#### CONSENT

Gauravi K. Majmundar, M.D., by affixing her signature hereon, agrees solely and exclusively for purposes of this agreement and the entry of the Order provided for and stated

herein, and proceedings conducted in accordance with this Order to the following:

1. Dr. Majmundar acknowledges that she is fully aware that, without her consent, no permanent legal action may be taken against her except after a hearing held in accordance with West Virginia Code §30-3-14(h) and §29A-5-1, et seq.;

2. Dr. Majmundar acknowledges that she has the following rights, among others: the right to a formal hearing before the West Virginia Board of Medicine, the right to reasonable notice of said hearing, the right to be represented by counsel at her own expense, and the right to cross-examine witnesses against her;

3. Dr. Majmundar waives all rights to such a hearing;

4. Dr. Majmundar consents to the entry of this Order relative to her practice of medicine in the State of West Virginia; and,

5. Dr. Majmundar understands that this Order is considered public information, and that matters contained herein may be reported, as required by law, to the National Practitioner Data Bank.

#### ORDER

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the Board, and on the basis of the consent of Dr. Majmundar, the West Virginia Board of Medicine hereby ORDERS as follows:

1. That the license to practice medicine and surgery of Dr. Majmundar, License No. 15832, is **SUSPENDED** effective April 15,

1998, for a one (1) year period until April 15, 1999, but that as of October 15, 1998, said suspension is **STAYED** for the remaining six (6) months of the period of suspension, and Dr. Majmundar shall be placed on probation effective October 15, 1998, for a period of three (3) years and or until such time as she completes the three (3) year term of supervised release imposed by the United States District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia in its April 25, 1997, Order, whichever first occurs: Provided, that Dr. Majmundar may resume her practice of medicine on or after October 15, 1998, only on the condition that she practice for the remaining six (6) months of the period of stayed suspension, and for the period of probation, under the supervision of a physician to be approved by the Board, the role of which supervising physician will be to assume responsibility for any and all of Dr. Majmundar's billing, and Dr. Majmundar shall submit to the Board on or before September 1, 1998, the names of three (3) physicians from which the Board may select such Board approved supervising physician.

2. Dr. Majmundar shall comply with all requirements of the United States District Court for the Southern District of West Virginia as contained in its Order of April 25, 1997.

3. Upon successful completion of all of the above requirements, as determined by the Board, Dr. Majmundar's license to practice medicine and surgery shall be reinstated in full by the Board.


4. Dr. Majmundar shall provide a copy of this Order to any employer or health care or medical facility where Dr. Majmundar


is practicing medicine, and during the period that this Order is in effect, Dr. Majmundar shall provide a copy of this Order to any prospective employer or health care or medical facility where she seeks to practice medicine.


